# Premier and ministers showcase Yukon’s mining industry at Roundup

WHITEHORSE (January 23, 2015) —Premier Darrell Pasloski and three Cabinet members will attend the Mineral Exploration Roundup in Vancouver next week to meet with industry representatives and showcase Yukon’s commitment to the industry.

The premier will be joined by: Minister of Energy Mines and Resources and Highways and Public Works Scott Kent; Minister of Economic Development Stacey Hassard; and Minister of Environment Wade Istchenko.

“We are proud of Yukon’s rich mining heritage, and from that foundation we are committed to building a strong and long-lasting industry in the territory,” Pasloski said.

Yukon’s attendance at the four-day event is an opportunity for members of the industry to meet with government ministers and officials, and for Yukon government geologists to present their latest research and findings.

“Roundup is the prime venue for the talented team at the Yukon Geological Survey to highlight their cutting-edge geoscience and mineral resource expertise to industry and to their peers,” Kent said.

In addition to Yukon government promoting its advantages as a place to explore and mine, there are several Yukon-based businesses that exhibit their skills and services at the conference.

“The investment potential in Yukon remains very strong,” Hassard added. “We are proud to support the companies that do business in Yukon and we will continue to expand our reach to the global audience.”

The Mineral Exploration Roundup, organized by the Association for Mineral Exploration British Columbia, runs from January 26 to 29. At the 2014 event, 6,600 participants from 37 countries attended.

Premier Pasloski and former Minister of Economic Development Currie Dixon also attended the Vancouver Resource Investment Conference last Sunday, where they spoke to guests at the opening of the Yukon Pavilion. The event, sponsored by Cambridge House, is the largest resource investment conference in the world and provides a valuable avenue to promote Yukon’s resource opportunities.

## Uffish Thoughts: Select Committee Report not all it was Fracked Up to be

As I feared, the report of the Select Committee Regarding the Risks and Benefits of Hydraulic Fracturing is a document that will be as widely interpreted as the *Bible* or the *Koran (Qur'an)*, with various groups staking out their ideological ground and proof-texting the report to prove the righteousness of their points of view.

Back when I was getting my Bachelor's degree in Sociology my professors used to say that any consultant who produced a study of which the main recommendation was that more study was needed should be made to consume his or her three by five cards or punch cards (this was before personal computers) and retire from the field in disgrace.

That's probably not a fair judgment to pass on the process just concluded, but seeing minority reports springing out of the main report within less than 48 hours is a fair sign that nothing has been produced other than the manure which will be used to fertilize the next territorial election campaign.

We're hearing a new term

this week: "social licence". It's being interpreted as the will of the people expressed through something other than the ballot box, as if petitions and surveys should take precedence over more traditional measures of public confidence.

Not that there isn't some logic to the phrase. The numbers do seem to indicate a strong preference for the Peel Commission's plan over the government's, and there was certainly a massive preponderance of people opposed to fracking during the committee's hearings.

There's lots wrong with our current electoral system. I'm personally of the opinion that any governing party that can't claim the allegiance of the majority of those who voted (because those who don't vote should simply shut up) should tread carefully around the sort of language that Premier Pasloski and his cabinet members have been using lately.

"Public government" is one of the other recently minted terms that seems to say so much but really says nothing. A public government would, to my way of thinking, be transparent in its operations. It would not fail

to show up (like those who don't vote) during public consultations because it knew all along that it was planning to ignore the results of those deliberations and trot out its own counter proposals in its own good time.

It would not refuse to speak about a subject like land planning during an election and then produce its jack-in-the-box surprise afterwards, claiming that the mandate for this move came from the voters' response to an election platform of which this was not a plank.

Don't assume I'm necessarily writing in favour of the Peel Commission's plan. I've said before that I think both reports are flawed and that a truly negotiated compromise would not have looked like either of them. What I am clear about is whose fault it is that real negotiations never took place. The commission was willing; the government wasn't.

If we are now stuck with a lop-sided ruling by the courts, a ruling that as far as I can tell, gives an accurate account of the government's failure to participate, it's clear whose fault that was.

"Coalition" as in the Yukon

Party Caucus' references to an "Opposition coalition" has cropped up in a number of press releases lately. This is a Harperite formulation that came into conservative vogue when Mr. Harper's minority government nearly got scuppered after misreading the fiscal tea leaves back in 2008.

As a bit of political misdirection, it sounded so righteous and ignored Mr. Harper's own attempt to form a coalition to take down the Martin minority government just a few years earlier. As a slur it ignored the fact that coalitions are entirely legal and constitutional and not some back door trick for gaining power.

During part of World War I, which we have been commemorating lately, Canada was governed by a coalition government known by the name Unionist, and containing twelve Conservatives, nine Liberals and Independents and one "Labour" member.

The current government of the United Kingdom is a coalition of Conservatives and Liberal Democrats.

It happens, Get over it. Mess up badly enough and you deserve to get taken down.

But is there an Opposition Coalition in the Yukon at present? In my reading Liz Hanson's NDP would very much like to replace the Yukon Party and would not be interested in sharing the throne. Sandy Silver's Liberals have a much more extensive rebuilding job to complete and will likely need to spend a bit of time as more than a one man show before gaining control of the Leg.

On the other hand, the Yukon Party's fondness for using Mr. Silver's full name and placing him ahead of the nameless members of the NDP in their pronouncements would seem to indicate that they view his ascension as a greater threat.

Sandy winces when I say this, but lots of people do remember what happened the last time the Liberals peaked too soon, whereas the last two NDP governments really weren't bad at all.

To conclude, however, it appears that the Select Committee's report is not all it was fracked up to be. Too bad, even if it was predictable.

# Remembering Ted Harrison

Ted Harrison died yesterday at the age of 88. Back in the late 1970s, Mr. Harrison was a high school teacher of mine here in Whitehorse. I remember him as a kind-hearted, friendly, joyful, passionate - and very CREATIVE - person. He always had a smile on his face and seemed to find the time to connect with every one of his students.

Ted Harrison looked at the sky and found the time to praise its unique beauty. He coloured and shaped our northern world in ways some of us could not even imagine, even though we saw it with our own eyes every day. He saw it differently and boldly brushed it into wild shapes and coloured it with the full-spectrum. He quenched our

thirst to see our ordinary world in an extraordinary way. I remember Dad telling us that Ted Harrison had told him that he had painted the Snider family in front of a church scene in one of his paintings. Years later I came across that very painting in Hawaii while house-sitting for some former Yukoners. There was my family, in colour and in light, the way Ted Harrison had seen us. Today when I take the time to look at the sky, it will feel a little bit brighter, perhaps even a little more colourful, as I hold Mr. Harrison close to my heart. His legacy will live on through his distinctive art that is a treasure to Yukon and Canada."

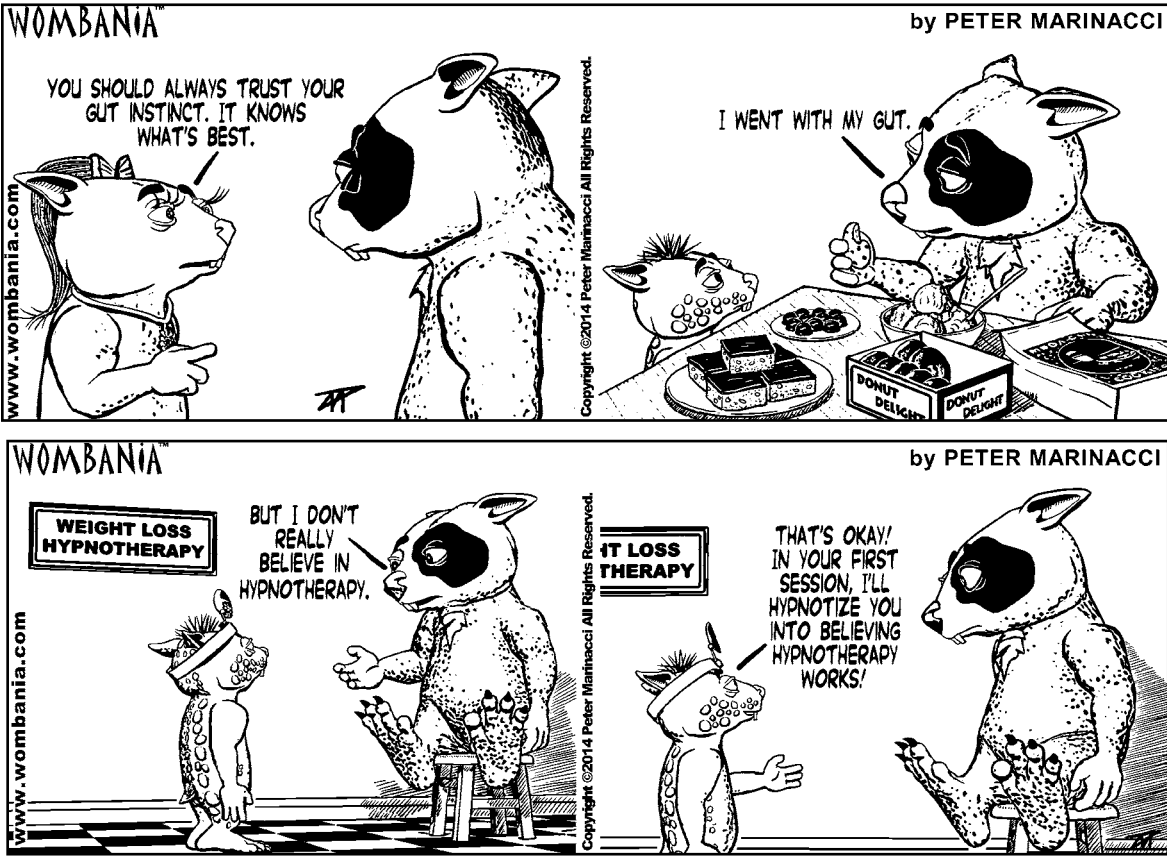
Harrison's artwork is displayed around the world in public and private collections including at the University of Victoria, the Government of Yukon Main Administration Building and the Prime Minister's residence in Ottawa. He received the Order of Canada for his contribution to Canadian culture, however the National Gallery of Canada has yet to add Harrison's work to their revered collection. "In 2009, the National Gallery of Canada was asked to add Mr. Harrison's work to their collection to capture the full range of Canada's art, including Yukon," Premier Pasloski added. "Today, we call on the gallery to revisit their decision and acquire his work, which reflects the entire Yukon. He is an iconic figure in the Canadian art scene and Canadians deserve to have artwork from across our nation on display in our national collection."

## YOOP Hall packed beyond capacity and cleared by Fire Chief as McDiarmid jury selection gets under way

(Jan. 19, 2015) Jury selection in the case of the Crown vs. Mark McDiarmid ran over two days. Dawsonites were crammed like sardines into an over crowded Yukon Order of Pioneers Hall on Monday morning (Jan. 19) until noon to listen and respond to the over 300 names of potential jurors that was read out by the Deputy Sheriff.

The list included some 142 people who answered to the call, while others were found to be travelling, had moved, were halfway round the world, were only seasonal residents and, in a couple of cases, deceased.

McDiarmid, who is representing himself, complained that First Nations citizens were under represented in the polling, but was informed that the names all came from the territory's health records.

The defendant was seated at the right of the hall, as viewed from the gallery, wearing a set of ankle chains and checking off names on his own list of potential jurors.

The Crown indicates that this case could run as long as six weeks, though Judge Hughes was quick to remind everyone that it will simply take as long as it takes, and that the estimate is not a guarantee.

Due to the length of the trial the judge intends to select 14 jurors, along with two alternates. Only 12 can actually

vote on the final verdict, so the jury will be reduced by lot when that time comes.

Mark McDiarmid, 36, has been in custody at the Whitehorse Correctional Centre since October 2011, when the alleged altercation with Dawson City RCMP took place. McDiarmid was shot by police during the incident.

He's facing seven charges – damaging a police vehicle, three counts of assaulting police officers, possessing a weapon for a dangerous purpose, and two counts of attempted murder.

Details of the events, which occurred on Oct. 19 and 20, 2011, are protected by a publication ban.

The court was just getting to the business of interviewing potential jurors when applause broke out at the back of the room with the arrival of Dawson Fire Chief Jim Regimbal, who insisted that the proceedings come to a halt and the room be cleared as it was well over its carrying capacity and constituted a "ridiculous" fire hazard.

Apparently some of the folks in the audience had texted Regimbal that he really needed to come and take a look at the situation. The crowd had filled all the chairs including those set aside at the front for the jury. It had lined the walls on both sides of the room, filled the cloak room hallway and the spilled onto the deck outside the building. During the roll call of citizens, people at the back

assisted the deputy by checking in those areas for those who could not be seen and, in the very poor acoustics on the room, could not hear their names being called out.

McDiarmid pointed out that it had been his preference to hold this gathering in the much larger Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in Community Hall.

Regimbal stated that he was not leaving until there were

not more than 60 people in the hall and so the court clerk was instructed to draw 20 names for immediate interviews and another 30 for a second set to begin at 2 p.m.

Hearing many grumbles of "not coming back" when she announced that everyone else would have to reappear the next morning at 9:30, the judge announced that she would issue arrest warrants for any one

who did not come as required by law.

Even with the potential jurors being interviewed in groups, that will still end up with too many people in the hall on Tuesday, and Regimbal says he will force the trial to move elsewhere if necessary.

# McDiarmid Jury Selection completed on Second Day

Jury selection was nearly complete by about 12:30 on the second day (Jan. 20) of Mark McDiarmid’s trial in Dawson City. Six jurors were selected on Monday and the remaining eight, plus two alternates, were picked on Tuesday.

As promised, Fire Chief Jim Regimbal was on site at 9:30 to make sure that the court did not repeat Monday’s violation of the fire safety regulations, but the court had got the message the day before.

Judge Elizabeth Hughes retained 50 citizens for the morning’s jury selection exercise, dismissing the rest

until 1:30 in the afternoon.

By 12:30 the main jury contingent, set at 14 for this trial, had been selected, plus one alternate juror. The number of 14 is unusual, and the judge said the jury would have to be reduced to the more standard 12 when it came time to render the final verdict.

Potential jurors were let go for a number of reasons. Some were found to be unacceptable by the two “tryers” on the existing jury, having answered in the negative about their ability to come to an unbiased decision in the case based solely on the evidence presented in the trial.

One person was exempted from duty as being over the age of 65. One man was exempted because his wife is likely to have to travel to Whitehorse to give birth during the projected six weeks set aside for the case. Several persons had travel plans already booked that fell within the time frame, while others had scheduled medical treatments, procedures or operations that hit the same dates. A couple of people had ongoing health issues that rendered them unsuitable.

Some people had jobs for which they were essential personnel and could not be replaced: a worker at the Macdonald Lodge Seniors home;

another who operates the snow plough at the airport. After one of the key personnel at the Klondike Visitors Association was selected, a second KVA worker was excused on the grounds that it would have shut down some essential seasonal work at the office.

Other candidates were deemed to have too close a relationship to either McDiarmid or to some of the witnesses on either side of the case. Members of the Canadian Rangers were dismissed.

Some people made it all the way through the judge’s questions about bias and were found acceptable by both “tryers”, only to be “challenged”

by either McDiarmid or Crown Prosecutor David McWhinnie. Neither counsel is required to explain what moves them to issue a challenge, so the selection process remains rather mystifying to the gallery. Most challenges were issued by McWhinnie.

After two days in the Yukon Order of Pioneers Hall, the trial will now move to the court room in the Old Territorial Administration Building, which is currently the home of the Dawson City Museum. The Dawson Court Registry is located in the north end of the building.

## Sergeant had the fright of his life, he tells the court

“I was shook up. It was the most scared I’d ever been,” said Sgt. David Wallace, speaking on Jan. 21, and describing his reactions on October 19, 2011, the day that Mark McDiarmid came at his police truck with a sledge hammer, smashing the driver’s side headlight, denting the fender and putting a hole through the windshield directly in front of where Wallace was sitting.

Wallace had retreated back into his vehicle when what he thought would be a routine contact with McDiarmid suddenly went sour. Wallace had sought out McDiarmid to have him come to the detachment and settle some issues related to his bail conditions. He had spoken with McDiarmid about a similar matter back in August without it creating any sort of altercation, so he had been taken by surprise when the latter had reacted negatively, had rummaged in the cab of his truck and had pulled out a blue sledgehammer.

Wallace, who had exited his truck to talk to McDiarmid outside his mother’s home on Boutillier Road, had begun to retreat to his vehicle when McDiarmid appeared angry and uncooperative.

He told Crown Prosecutor David McWhinnie that his first thought was that McDiarmid was reaching for a rifle. He didn’t know just why that came to mind, since his relations with the man had been cordial up to then. Earlier in August, before the first bail incident, he had stopped to

assist McDiarmid when his truck quit on Pierre Berton Drive, and had used the police truck to tow him to a safer parking place.

He conceded that his thoughts were no doubt coloured by news of an incident that had occurred to a colleague in another community.

With Wallace backing his truck out of reach, McDiarmid exited the other end of the short residential road on to the Klondike Highway and headed south across the Ogilvie Bridge. Wallace, in his damaged vehicle, returned to the Front Street detachment and reported the events to his superiors in Whitehorse.

Wallace went on to describe in some detail the events of the next day, during which six officers, in three vehicles, attempted to apprehend McDiarmid in the area of the North Fork Road and Dempster Highway. Acting on information that the suspect was working in a woodlot fairly near the Tr’ondëk Hwëch’in’s R22 compound, the police planned to box him in on the side road, deflate his tires with a spike belt if he attempted to run, and take him into custody.

The plan was somewhat frustrated by poor communications. The police radios needed a repeater boost in order to allow them to communicate with each other and they had to relay from vehicle to vehicle as the hours wore on towards twilight and darkness on that October evening. In the event, McDiarmid rolled over the spike belt and continued to the junction of the North Fork

Road and Dempster Highways, turning north before coming to a stop.

He was closely followed in a police car by Constables Jeff Nielson and David Marentette, who pulled up behind him when he came to a stop. By then, Wallace and Const. McIntyre had cleared away the spike belt and begun to follow the other two vehicles. Wallace said he was exiting his vehicle when he heard the others say that shots had been fired.

In the Crown’s summary of the events, Prosecutor Jennifer Grandy had earlier described how McDiarmid came out of his truck, threw a jar filled with some gasoline compound at the constables and advanced on them with what turned out to be a splitting maul, but which Wallace thought at the time was a large axe.

Wallace said that Nielson fired two shots and Marentette fired one.

He approached McDiarmid, who was lying on the ground, and tried to ascertain the extent of his injuries. The man said nothing at first, but did eventually complain that his hands, cuffed behind his back, were getting cold. Wallace observed that he was sweating and, concerned that he might be going into shock, had him conveyed to the rear of one of the police cruisers, to keep him warm while they continued to look for his wounds. They only located two of the three.

One of the cruisers had been dispatched to get to within radio range in order to request an EMS ambulance, which was reported to be on its way, but Wallace decided it would be

best to go and meet it, which they did about 35 minutes later, just north of the Dawson City Airport.

Later examination at the Dawson City Health Centre (this happened before the new hospital was built) revealed McDiarmid was shot twice around his right hip and once in his left shoulder.

Cpl. Dave Morin (since promoted to Sgt., and now in charge of the Dawson detachment) was left on the Dempster to secure the scene, and isolate the constables in separate vehicles while they recorded the event separately. He also confiscated their duty belts, which Wallace said was standard procedure in such cases.

The pair, who are no longer posted in Dawson, were cleared of any wrong doing just over a year later in a report from the Alberta Serious Incident Response Team (ASIRT).

Earlier in the day, Judge Elizabeth Hughes instructed the jury in the niceties of court procedure, their

duty to deliberate only on the evidence presented and clues by which they might be expected to evaluate testimony.

Wallace’s testimony took up the rest of the morning and continued after the noon break until 4:30.

A good deal of the crown’s questioning had to do with the exact locations where events took place, the special relationships between the various officers and the accused, identifying marks on the various vehicles and lots of physical minutia. There was much repetition, as well as identification of locations on sketch maps and aerial photographs.

## Strong privacy practices are good for business, says federal Privacy Commissioner

Businesses that don't have strong privacy controls risk losing their competitive advantage in today's increasingly privacy conscious marketplace, Privacy Commissioner of Canada Daniel Therrien warns as countries around the world mark Data Privacy Day, January 28th.

But it's a message that isn't just for major companies. It's for the thousands of smaller businesses operating across Canada in tiny towns and bustling metropolises from coast, to coast, to coast. In fact, 98 per cent of companies in Canada employ fewer than 100 people.

"I understand that smaller businesses face many compliance pressures on top

of day-to-day operational demands, but strong privacy practices are not just good for customers; they're good for the bottom line," says Commissioner Therrien.

"Canadians are telling us that they prefer to do business with companies that have good privacy practices."

About a third of all private sector privacy complaints under Canada's federal private sector privacy law, the *Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act*, appear to involve smaller businesses.

Landlords, hotels, real estate agencies, collection agencies, travel agencies, independent local retailers and financial planners are among the types of businesses in the community that are at the centre of these complaints.

Commissioner Therrien says businesses often don't realize that what they're doing could create unnecessary risks for privacy.

Many grievances about smaller businesses involve things such as the improper use or sharing of a person's information. This can be as simple as a misdirected letter, he says, and as serious as an employee snooping into a client's personal file.

"Smaller businesses need to ask themselves what proactive measures they are taking to safeguard the privacy of their customers and to mitigate data breaches," says Commissioner Therrien.

"As we mark Data Privacy Day, I would encourage

all businesses to use this opportunity to take stock of, and strengthen where necessary, their privacy practices. My office is here to help."

Key steps to get on the right privacy track include:

- Limit the amount of customer information you collect to what is necessary for the purposes of delivering a product or service.

- Make it clear to customers in an easy-to-understand privacy policy why you need and how you'll handle their personal information.

- Know exactly what you collect, how it's stored, who has access to it, how long it's kept and when and how it's discarded.

- Train staff on the importance of privacy protection.

- Don't collect sensitive information, such as health or financial data, if you don't have to.

- Respond to customer requests for access to their personal information and designate a point person to respond to customer questions about privacy.

## Adult FASD diagnostic team to be established in Yukon

WHITEHORSE (January 14, 2015)—Training will begin this month for professionals who will make up the diagnostic team for adults suspected of having Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD). This team will complement the early childhood and youth diagnostic teams already in place.

"This is an exciting time in Yukon with so many good things happening locally that can impact the lives of individuals with FASD and their families," Minister of Health and Social Services Doug Graham said.

A pool of local physicians

and psychologists will be trained to build capacity among service providers in Yukon. Focus will be on functional assessments to identify an adult's strengths and needs. Assessment results will help in the development of supportive strategies for those individuals.

Previously, the government funded the Fetal Alcohol Syndrome Society of Yukon (FASSY) to bring in an assessment team from outside Yukon. Between 2004 and 2013 an average of six adults were assessed yearly. With a team located in Yukon, more assessments can be completed per year.

"This is just one initiative that will better support individuals with FASD," Graham added. "We recently completed an analysis to identify gaps and duplications in the prevention services we offer in Yukon. The report identified a number of recommendations, many of which we are now acting upon."

In addition to the new local diagnostic team, the Yukon government is addressing identified gaps in FASD prevention by:

- funding a new sexual health clinic in Whitehorse that provides accessible information

and services related to sexual health, including the risks of drinking while pregnant;

- partnering with community agencies to develop awareness campaigns and integrate information into school curriculum about the risks of alcohol; and

- creating an interdepartmental committee to improve coordination for collaborative action on FASD. This committee will be responsible for coordinating FASD-related activities occurring within

government including: screening and assessment; provision of support services; education and training; research and evaluation; as well as awareness and prevention. This new committee, once established, will create a more seamless response.



# “Burning Daylight” lit up the Odd Fellows Hall

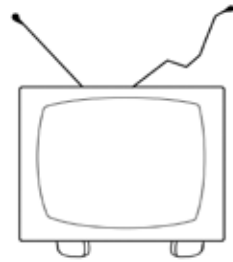

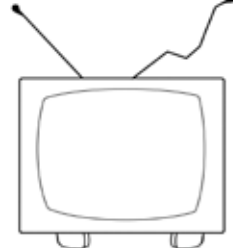

## Bruce Cockburn's still kicking at the darkness

### *Rumours Of Glory:* *a Memoir*

"This is not your standard rock and roll memoir. You won't find me snorting coke with young Elton John or shooting smack with Keith Richards; dangling babies from hotel balconies or fleeing rehab; shooting guns or sleeping with someone else's wife. Well ... you will find me shooting guns and sleeping with someone else's wife, and these are significant elements of my tale."

So begins Bruce Cockburn's memoir, the story of a mild mannered guitar player who seems to have spent his life trying to get outside himself, who has often been the author of his own misfortune (he says) when it comes to relationships, who was a long time getting to the place in his head and heart where he could actually like the audiences for whom he was playing, and who has a complicated relationship with Jesus Christ, whom he is sure has visited him in spirit at least twice.

Confession time. I have been a Cockburn fan since the early 1970s, which puts me pretty close to the beginning of his solo career. I have Bruce copied on cassette tapes borrowed from friends in those days. I have still more Bruce on vinyl, on legitimate cassettes, on CDs and even on mp3 downloads (just because it's nice to have some of that stuff on my iPod). I've even managed to figure out how to perform covers of some of his material, though

my guitar skills are barely up to the challenge.

Cockburn starts with the guitar. His devotion to the instrument is what launched him on the path he has followed throughout his career. Prior to going solo, he was in a number of groups, from rock to folk, and those influences have showed up in his playing all through his career.

His parents didn't have this career in mind for him, but they also didn't get in his way much when it became clear that nothing else would do. They did, however, insist that he take guitar lessons.

"I took my lessons. I learned some standard tunes and lot of basic guitar techniques. Hank (Sims) introduced me to the music of Chet Atkins and Les Paul. And though I waited until I thought my parents wouldn't care anymore, in the fullness of time I acquired sideburns, and a leather jacket, and I played in a rock-and-roll band."

Four themes – the music, relationships, Christianity and human rights – chase themselves back and forth through this book. There are quite a few song lyrics in the text, preceded by his accounts of where they came from and what he was attempting to do with them. If you don't have the complete Cockburn, the way I do, you can buy an 8 CD/DVD box set with the same name and containing all the songs referenced in the book.

If you don't want to do that, but can't quite recall the tune that goes with the lyrics, there's a website (<http://bc.bc.com>) that contains one minute samples of all 117 songs. The links won't work on your basic Kindle reader, but they work most of the time on an iPad mini and all the time if you access the site on a laptop.

Cockburn can play blistering

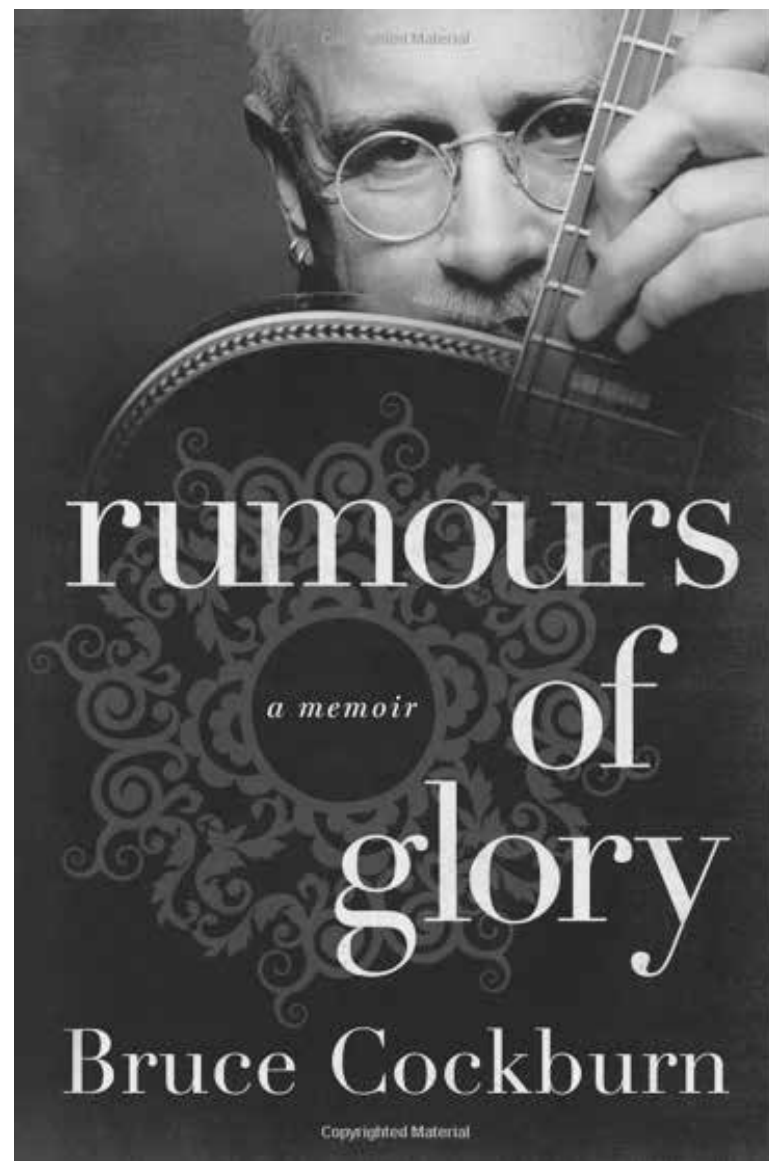
leads, and has done so on albums from his middle period on, but his basic fingering style is something that he calls a collision between the fingering patterns of his right hand and the somewhat jazz oriented chords that he learned to love with his left hand during his incomplete stay at the Berklee College of Music in Boston, which began when he was 19.

Relationships are a thorny subject for Cockburn. His first marriage lasted quite a few years and produced a child, referenced in "The Laugh" but it ended, and he blames himself for an inability to share deeply enough. In "What About the Bond?" he examined the pain of a man who truly believed in the marriage oath and yet could not cope.

It would be years before he would marry again, though he had a number of long term relationships (including that one with Madame X, the married woman) prior to finally marrying M.J. Hannett and embarking once more on parenthood. Some of the relationships he ended, others were ended for him as partners burned out bumping up against what he calls his own reclusiveness.

While Cockburn frequently declares himself to be disenchanted with organized religion, and organized Christianity (he was vaguely Anglican when he attended regularly) his lyrics, somewhat like Bono's (of U2) are frequently leavened with references to the teachings of Christ, whom he continues to revere.

"When Jesus came into my life, in 1974, he also made it into the music. Since then our relationship, like most relationships, has ebbed and flowed. I have tried to keep Jesus the compassionate



activist close to my heart, along with Jesus as portal to the cosmos, but I have long been leery of the dogma and doctrine that so many have attached to Christianity as well as to most other religions."

About those guns. Cockburn

took up shooting as a hobby sport after losing most of the sight in one eye. So it's really got nothing to do with "If I had a Rocket Launcher".

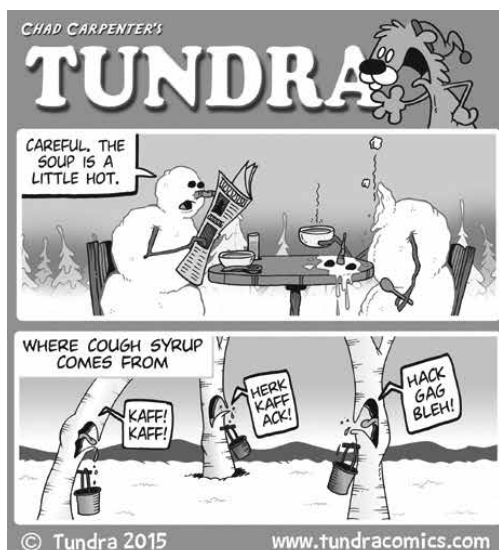

The Fracking Reactions  
Report Shows Fracking  
Unsafe, Opposed By  
Yukoners

WHITEHORSE (January 20, 2015) —The Yukon NDP has heard the scientific community and Yukoners loud and clear: fracking cannot occur in Yukon in the face of significant doubts about the safety of the process. While the fracking committee’s final report may present divided opinions on the future of fracking in Yukon, witnesses from the scientific community and the Yukon public were unequivocal about the potential social and environmental harm that fracking could cause.

“The scientific evidence presented to the committee was clear: there just isn’t a proven safe way to frack,” said MLA Lois Moorcroft, who sat on the committee alongside MLA Jim Tredger on behalf of Yukon NDP. “The negative impacts of fracking are just too risky – especially compared to the benefits Yukoners would receive through investments in renewable energy.”

“Over the course of our committee work, we heard from hundreds of Yukoners who were overwhelmingly opposed to fracking,” said Tredger. “Yet, I am concerned that the Yukon Party government will not listen and is determined to plough through with its oil and gas agenda – despite the groundswell of opposition to fracking we experienced at the public consultations.”

In spite of the overwhelming scientific evidence of high risks related to fracking and nearly unanimous opposition during public hearings, the committee could not agree on whether or not fracking should be allowed in Yukon – or even whether social licence, the broader public support for a project, should exist prior to fracking.

“Anyone who reads the report would agree that fracking shouldn’t be allowed in Yukon. It isn’t safe and Yukoners don’t want it,” added Moorcroft. “Unfortunately, the government’s oil and gas agenda wouldn’t allow its committee members to come to this obvious conclusion.”

Whitehorse (January 20, 2015) Sandy Silver today issued the following statement on the Select Committee Report on Fracking:

“At this time there are too many unknowns to support fracking in the Yukon. While the techniques used in extracting shale gas are understood, more research is needed to explore the environmental, health and water impacts that will result from this process.

At this time there is little buy-in or social license from Yukoners regarding fracking. Gaining social acceptance would be essential before fracking could proceed.

A massive effort in targeted science is required to understand all the health and environmental impacts of shale gas development. Currently, data about environmental, health and water impacts are neither sufficient nor conclusive.

The recommendations contained in the report are not binding on the Government of Yukon.

A Liberal government would not issue permits for fracking given what I heard from academic experts, Yukoners, and First Nation governments.”

Yukon Party government responds to

WHITEHORSE (January 21, 2015)—The Yukon Party Caucus is dismayed to hear the anti-development comments emerging from the Opposition coalition in response to the recently released report of the Select Committee Regarding the Risks and Benefits of Hydraulic Fracturing.

“Sandy Silver and the NDP are once again siding together to stifle yet another industry in Yukon,” said Premier Darrell Pasloski. “Our government is taking the necessary time to do an in-depth analysis of the report of the select committee, while some Opposition MLAs couldn’t even wait for the committee’s work to be done before taking a position. The NDP were front and centre at anti-fracking demonstrations, for example. As for Sandy Silver, as usual, he changes his tune depending on who he thinks is listening.”

Yukon Party Caucus researchers have also reviewed a copy of Petition #7 submitted to the Yukon Legislative Assembly (YLA) by the NDP, as supplied by the YLA Office. After multiple submissions by the NDP, the total number of pages attached to the petition is now 189. The NDP claims of approximately 7400 signatures appears inaccurate, as each page holds 20 signature spots, allowing for a maximum of 3780 signatures. A preliminary review of the petition also shows multiple blank lines and duplicate signatures suggesting an even lower total. The NDP should explain their submitted documentation that conflicts with their claims of 7400 signatures.

“Since the Opposition Coalition does not form government, they sometimes take liberties in representing their opinions as fact,” added Pasloski. “As a sitting government, we know that Yukoners deserve more - a government that does its homework and clarifies the facts. Sadly, we are once again tasked with fact-checking information presented to the public by the opposition.”

If Yukoners want to check the facts for themselves, they can request a copy of the petition through their MLA, who can obtain it from the Yukon Legislative Assembly office
